add one more group of 4

5) $3 \times 8 = \underline{24}$

start with 2×8

$$2 \times 8 = \underline{16}$$

add one more group of 8

$$\underline{16} + 8 = \underline{24}$$

6) $6 \times 8 = \underline{48}$

start with 5×8

$$5 \times 8 = \underline{40}$$

add one more group of 8

$$\underline{40} + 8 = \underline{48}$$

7) $6 \times 3 = \underline{18}$

start with 2×6

$$2 \times 6 = \underline{12}$$

add one more group of 6

$$\underline{12} + 6 = \underline{18}$$

8) $4 \times 6 = \underline{24}$

start with 5×4

$$5 \times 4 = \underline{20}$$

add one more group of 4

$$\underline{20} + 4 = \underline{24}$$
